Scientific journal “**Innovative projects and programs in education**” is registered by the Federal service for supervision of communications, information technology and mass media (**registration number and date: series PI № FS77-73046 of 06.06.2018**). The founder of the journal is State Autonomous Educational Institution of Additional Professional Education of the Moscow Region “Corporate University for Educational Development”.

The editorial policy of the journal is based on the requirements to mass media and copyright protection, imposed by international and Russian law. The editorial team follows ethics standards and principles common within the community of scientific periodicals publishers.

The major issue of the journal policy is obligatory peer review which is implemented according to the established review procedure.

The aim of the journal is to contribute to the development of open information environment of the teaching community for an effective exchange of information, ideas, and research results in education to foster the development of the Russian education and support Russian educational researchers in joining the world common education space.

The focal area of the journal:

- creating a professional platform for discussing fundamental research in education and the results of empirical research aimed at the study of educational policy, mechanisms of its implementation and the working out of approaches to understanding the new education paradigm, new education goals and values in modern society;
- drawing attention to the most actual and promising directions of scientific research on the journal subject matter;
- presenting current issues in education and education policy;
- providing the exchange of ideas of scholars from different regions of Russia as well as other countries;
- meeting the international standards of scientific publications;
- creating an information field for scholars and practitioners in the sphere of educational innovations.
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The main categories of the magazine:

- Education development strategies.
- Genesis and theoretical and methodological basis of professional education pedagogy.
- Character formation in educational organizations.
- Research and innovation projects, programs, approaches.
- Specialist training at institutions of higher vocational education.
- Specialist training at institutions of secondary vocational education.
- Retraining and professional development of education teachers.

- Modern technologies in education.
- Pedagogical problems of career guidance of students.
- Education management.

The papers published in the journal are of theoretical and practical significance, for they comprise the innovative results:

- a) of all research on education advancement, conducted within the framework of RAS subject coverage
- b) of research in pedagogy held within the framework of the following specialization code:
5.8.7 – methodology and technology of professional education (pedagogical sciences).

The journal has 6 issues annually.

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Based on the agreement with the Scientific e-library of 2008, full texts of the articles are included into RSCI and available to subscribers online.
